WHO'S WHO SURVEY

A professional survey of projects, groups and agencies provides detailed profiles as a base for a community arts and culture network.

Needs: survey staff and database.

COMMUNITY RESEARCH

Training courses equip local people to research local issues for themselves and prepare action plans.

Needs: research trainers, interested activists.

1



PARTICIPATION TRAINING

Programme staff are trained in participation methods and anti-discriminatory practice.

Needs: participation trainers.

CAPACITY BUILDING

Agencies and residents learn in linked programmes how to work together more effectively on participation strategies.

Needs: agency commitment and capacity builders.

2



PARTNERSHIP BUILDING

Trainers and facilitators work with local partnerships to help them operate more effectively both formally and informally.

Needs: partnerships trainers.

2



CITIZENS COUNCIL

The local authority supports establishment of a Citizens Council to represent local interests.

Needs: Council commitment to participation, support staff.

COMMUNITY GARDENING

A community gardening project turns a derelict site into allotments.

Needs: volunteer gardeners.

DROP IN CENTRE

A vacant shop is converted to a drop-in resource centre and neighbourhood learning centre next to shops, mosque, health centre.

Needs: funding, organisation to manage centre development and operation.

LEARNING AMBASSADORS

Residents become advocates for adult learning through a two-year programme.

Needs: funding, adult learning tutors

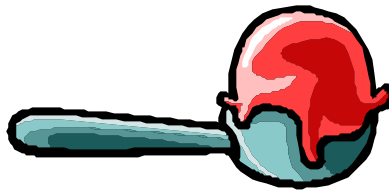


LEADERSHIP TRAINING

The local advice centre offers programmes in community mapping/ advocacy/lobbying skills linked to community leadership training.

Needs: Funding, leadership trainers.

MOBILE ADVICE VAN

A converted ice cream van promotes 'stop me and try one' activities to engage local interest.

Needs: funding for van conversion, staff/volunteers.

COMMUNITY CAFÉ

An empty house is converted into a community café with child care facilities and room for arts and culture workshops.

Needs: Funding for to café conversion. Staffing/volunteers.

LETS SCHEME

A LETS scheme linked to residents committee and local ACL provider helps facilitate community activities and trading.

Needs: Funding to kick start, and LETS organiser.

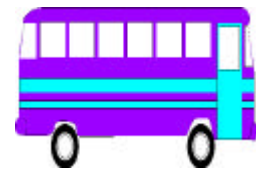


AGEWELL PROJECT

A project worker develops learning and support groups for older residents.

Needs: revenue funding and specialist support organisation.

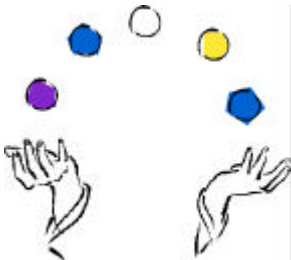


MOBILE LIBRARY

A mobile library calls once a week with books in minority languages and online computers via satellite link.

Needs: capital for library and revenue for staff. Technical support.

COMMUNITY THEATRE

A community theatre company visits three times a year to work with residents and stage events highlighting local issues.

Needs: revenue to pay theatre company and organiser.

NEWSLETTER

A community newsletter group is funded and facilitated by Workers Education Association

Needs: funding, WEA commitment, interested residents.

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPH

Digital cameras, a lap-top and a printer enable residents to create a local exhibition.

Needs: Arts and culture project funding, interested photographers and organiser.

DANCE WORKSHOPS

A dance group encourage community dance activities in different local venues.

Needs: Dance group, funding for them.

RESIDENTS' VIDEO

Residents - with professional support and equipment – make a video on life in the area. It is screened in community locations and at official events.

Needs: funding, professional video support.

COMMUNITY ARTS WORKER

A short-term contract worker helps residents develop multi-media approaches to reflecting life in the area

Needs: funding, recruitment of arts worker, management.

ARTIST IN RESIDENCE

An artist in residence is attached to local community centre.

Needs: funding, recruitment of artist, management.

ARTS AND MUSIC WORKSHOPS

Workshops are organised by the Voluntary Arts Network in collaboration with ACL providers

Needs: funding for workshop, promotion.

DIGITAL CHAMPIONS

Computer and video workshops help 'digital champions' work with volunteer mentors from media industries to bring alive the neighbourhood vision.

Needs: funding, champions, digital mentors, management.

MUSEUM OUTREACH

Museums develop outreach programmes to link their service with black and minority ethnic groups.

Needs: museum management commitment and funding.

STAFF DEVELOPMENT

Arts and culture managers and outreach staff are offered training and support materials to foster neighbourhood renewal work.

Needs: commitment management, funding for renewal training.
